The following terms and conditions apply to participation in the Call for Papers for the INTERSCHUTZ Forum.

1.	Participation in the Call for Papers is only possible for exhibitors at INTERSCHUTZ 2026.
2.	Through the Call for Papers, presenters from exhibitors can apply to give a presentation at the INTERSCHUTZ Forum 2026 on one of the topics listed in the topic overview. Duration of the contribution: approx. 15 minutes including Q&A for presentations and approx. 40 minutes for panel discussions.
3.	Applications are submitted online via the contact form on the INTERSCHUTZ 2026 website. Application deadline: 13 February 2026. After the deadline, the applications will be evaluated by Deutsche Messe AG. The main selection criteria are relevance and content related to the specified focus topics of INTERSCHUTZ 2026.
4.	<p>In order for the submitted application to be evaluated by Deutsche Messe AG, at least the following information is required:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• First and last name, position, company (of the speaker)• Presentation title in German and English (max. 100 characters each, including spaces)• Presentation language: German or English (AI translation provided by the organizer)• Short abstract (max. 950 characters including spaces, in German and English) <p>Purely promotional company/image presentations, as well as pre-recorded contributions without a live speaker/moderator, cannot be considered for the INTERSCHUTZ Forum.</p>
5.	<p>Applicants will be informed by email about the acceptance of their application. A thematic realignment of the contribution and reassignment to a focus topic is not possible after acceptance by Deutsche Messe AG. However, the content of the presentation can still be edited.</p> <p>After an application is accepted, the exhibitor must independently enter the details of their contribution via the online speaker portal 'talque'. Separate terms and conditions apply for registration with 'talque', which can be accessed in advance at https://web.talque.com/de/datenschutzerklaerung/. The login details for 'talque' will be sent to the speaker or the designated contact person by email. Deadline for exhibitors to complete their contributions: 29 May 2026!</p>
6.	Application and participation in the Call for Papers for the INTERSCHUTZ Forum are free of charge. If your application is selected, a fee of €949 plus VAT will apply for the binding booking of the slot.

When purchasing one of the ten available sponsorship packages, a slot on the stage is already included. Please note that the submission must still be made via the online form and will be taken into account in every case.
